

A League of Their Own: What's so unique about Systemic Formulas?

What sets Systemic Formulas into a class by themselves as a complete healing system and frankly, a new dimension of herbal and nutritional healing? It's actually three things not found in other herbal supplements: Bio Energy, Herbal Synergism, and Balance.

Bio Energy refers to the resonance pattern of the complete formula. Doc Wheelwright first measured the bio-energetic signature of the targeted body tissue and got a three-dimensional holographic pattern of key information – the height, breadth, and valence of the tissue matrix via its sine wave on an oscilloscope. Then he constructed the ingredients of his herbal nutritional formulas to match that unique signature.

Thus Wheelwright was able to construct, in homeopathic terms, a “vegetable sarcode” (resonance pattern) of a tissue such as kidneys, spleen, pancreas, or liver to name but a few. With proper ingredients, his resulting formula went far beyond traditional herbal medicine which is based on only two dimensions—that of biochemistry via the body's reaction to the alkaloids and components of the plants used, and that of nutrition or the vitamins, minerals, oils, enzymes, and amino acids inherent in the plants – and advanced herbology into the realm of bioenergy.

To accomplish this, he established the laws of **herbal synergism**. Wheelwright studied the ionization of herbs to determine if they exerted a stimulation, sedation, or a balanced-tonic effect. This research allowed him to choose the right herbs to accompany each other. He could then combine anabolic herbs for the building of tissue, or catabolic herbs to effect cleansing and stimulation of function, or balance the actions with poly-ionic factors to smooth the formula into effectiveness without side effects.

Beyond this, Wheelwright discovered that all herbs have strengths and weaknesses inherent in them. By properly combining different herbs, he could bolster the weaknesses of the single herbs, buffer or neutralize the side effects, and enhance the overall results by strengthening the healing powers of the beneficial properties. Wheelwright taught that the true therapeutic power of herbal medicine lay in the effective combination of compatible herbs.

By applying bio-energy as the matrix for selecting the herbs, vitamins, minerals, enzymes, cellular identity factors and amino acids that comprise a Systemic Formula, and his in-depth knowledge of synergism, Wheelwright ushered herbology into the 21st Century.

To find the herbs that contained the inherent vitality needed he incorporated Amazon herbs from Brazil because of their nascent, unhybridized, and vital properties. In establishing this element, he also ensured that the herbs were cultivated in their natural habitat without damage to the rain forest he so dearly loved. He created a new healing system.

Prior to Wheelwright, herbology was philosophically an allopathic healing practice. This means that if someone had a fever, then cooling herbs were used. If someone had a chill, then heating herbs were used. If there was dampness in the spleen, then drying herbs were used. This is the law of opposites or allopathic medicine.

Wheelwright established his healing system on **balance**. Rather than stimulate a weak or exhausted tissue and run the risk of over-stimulation, rather than sedate an overactive tissue that is only responding to the body's innate command and run the risk of over-sedation, Wheelwright built his system on the neutral force. Simply by supporting the targeted tissue to return to its optimal bio-energetic and biochemical blueprint, the tissue can rapidly restore its inherent health with systemic support. Rather than manipulating the body, Wheelwright created formulas that are simultaneously powerful, gentle, and effective. The modus operandi he employs is to apply 'balance' information and nutrition via the formula, and the result, then, is restoration of the body's ability to duplicate balance in its function.

This is critically important to understand, because we now have healing tools at our fingertips that, when properly administered, serve to assist the body to correct its imbalances while building the integrity of the entire organ system.

Thus Systemic Formulas, much to our patients' joy, are self-limiting formulas. The goal is to restore optimal health and function and discontinue the therapy. Success breeds success in clinical practice.
